## GROWING HEALTHY CARING COMMUNITIES

Highlights of 2007 funding for the Dr. Everett Chalmers Regional Hospital.



We did it! One-million dollars raised to help purchase a new Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) Unit.

Our two-year campaign is now complete thanks to our caring community and a partnership with the provincial government. The 5,400 square-foot expansion to the diagnostic imaging department cost \$5.8 million, which included the new permanent MRI unit.

Endowment funds continue to be an important source of funding. Provided in perpetuity, making it an "everlasting" gift, the income

from the fund is used as directed by the donor. Items funded included six motorized lifts for the family practice unit valued at \$60,000.

Restricted funds, raised through memorial donations and special events, help professional staff from various hospital departments to attend workshops and educational conferences, as well as provide small equipment items.

Disbursements made from the restricted funds totaled \$216,963.

This includes two pediatric cribs valued at \$16,800, and a NICU Giraffe Omnibed, a special incubator that is used for the most complex cases \$47,425.

Our community pulled together for the Lights for Life campaign raising over \$90,000 to help the cardiac assessment clinic purchase new equipment.
