LOVE YOUR LAB

The Love Your Lab campaign in 2017-2018 raised \$770,000 to purchase essential laboratory services at Horizon's Dr. Everett Chalmers Regional Hospital. The ten new pieces of equipment allow for faster processing times for waiting patients, as well as advanced testing to ensure faster diagnosis and treatment.

More than 4.5 million tests are conducted annually by the hospital's lab personnel. The Department of Laboratory Medicine is a busy department that serves every corner of our health care system, including local hospitals, health centres, clinics, the extramural program, and point-of-care testing programs.


